This funding cycle requires each organization to participate in the Peer Panel Review as well as submitting a completed application.

<u>May, 16 - 27 2016</u>	COP and CPP Panel Reviews (Schedule TBA)
<u>August, 2016</u>	COP and CPP funding recommendations are completed by the Allocations Committee of the Cultural Affairs Commission. Cultural Affairs Commission approves COP funding recommendations
<u>September, 2016</u>	City Council approves FY 2016-2017 City Budget COP and CPP organizations are notified of funding levels
<u>October 15, 2016</u>	FY15-16 COP Final Reports and September COP monthly report due
<u>October, 2016</u>	City Council approves FY 2016-17 COP Contracts COP Organizations sign contracts Contracts go to City Council to be approved
<u>November-December, 2016</u>	CPP Organizations sign contracts
<u>January, 2017</u>	COP organizations receive initial payment (Subject to change) (Additional payments are made according to the contract terms)
<u>September 30, 2017</u>	CPP Final Reports due for FY2016-17
<u>October 15, 2017</u>	COP Final Reports due for FY 2016-17

The Funding Period for FY16-17 is October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017
